BE verb

- It has relationship with the subject.
- There are three forms of the be verb
- Am
- Are
- is

The simple present tense +

Need

- I need a new jacket.
- She **needs** a new skirt.

Like

- You like the green t-shirt.
- He **likes** the red blouse.

Want

- They want small jackets.
- She **wants** a medium skirt.

Have

- We have green t-shirts.
- She **has** a yellow blouse.

The simple present tense -

Need

I don't need a new jacket.

She doesn't need a new skirt.



Like

You don't like the green t-shirt.

He doesn't like the red blouse.



Want

They don't want small jackets.

She doesn't need a medium skirt.



Have

We don't have green t-shirts.

She doesn't have a yellow blouse.

The simple present tense ?

Need

Do you need a new jacket?

-Yes, I do.

-No, I don't.

Like

Does he like the green shirt?

-Yes, he does

-No, he doesn't

Want

Do they want small jackets?

-Yes, they do.

-No, they don't.

Have

Does she have a yellow blouse?

-Yes, she does

-No, she doesn't.

Adjective placement

- Adjectives come before a noun.
- If there are two (or more) adjectives, use “and”.



Adjective placement

- He has a red scarf.
- He has brown shoes.
