PHRASAL VERBS WITH GET

Phrasal verb is an idiomatic phrase consisting of a verb and another element, typically either an adverb, as in *break down*, or a preposition, for example *see to*, or a combination of both, such as:

- ◉ *get along* *get carried away*
- ◉ *get it* *get it together*
- ◉ *get through* *get ahead*
- ◉ *get real* *get going*
- ◉ *get out of* *get over*



NON-ACTION VERBS:

- They are always in present simple not in continuous

ABSTRACT	be, believe, know, need, understand, remember, think, imagine, forget, mean, exist...
FEELINGS	like, dislike, love, hate, fear, envy, care...
SENSES	hear, see, feel, smell, taste, sound, seem
BELONGINGS	own, have, belong, possess
